BILL DENNIS MERIT AWARD

This is the most prestigious award presented annually to a member of the Association who has demonstrated Outstanding Merit and Contributions to the Association and the Central Service Profession.

This award was renamed in 2003 in Memory of William B. Dennis who had served as a member of the North Carolina Association for Hospital Central Service Professionals Board and the American Society Association for Hospital Central Service Professionals Board, President-Elect, and President. Bill was the Director of Central Service at Duke University Hospital in Durham, North Carolina. Bill was the President-Elect for the American Society Association for Hospital Central Service Professionals during his second term when he passed away. He was nationally recognized as a leader in the field of healthcare central service and was an active member of both NCAHCSP and ASHCSP.

The Award:
